Service Category Definitions
Emergency Heating and Cooling: Provides for the emergency repair and replacement of non-functioning household heating and cooling systems.
Wood, Propane and Oil: Financial assistance for the purchase of wood, propane, and oil for home heating.
Severe Weather Energy Assistance and Transportation Services: Assistance to address energy related emergency needs. Can include utility assistance, temporary housing, transportation, and portable heating and cooling.
Public Safety Power Shut-Off Preparedness: Services for medically vulnerable households in designated High-Fire Risk Areas. Includes risk assessments, supplies, and battery backups.
Utility Assistance: Financial assistance to reduce energy bills and prevent disconnection.
